<u>An Open Note to all County A.D.s and Spring Track Coaches</u> <u>Concerning</u> <u>The 2015 Morris County Championships</u>

First of all, I would like to thank all of you who over the years have conscientiously and painstakingly made the effort to take care of the many requests and requirements associated with this entry. Please convey to your bus drivers that when they drop off your team(s) at Boonton High School, they will receive instructions concerning the parking of their vehicles if they intend to wait there for your team(s) until the end of the Meet. They will not be parking their buses at the high school. There will be a different site for that purpose located a short distance from the school.
- 3. Attached you will also find directions concerning the Certificate of Insurance that each school must send TO ME. If I do not receive this Certificate of Insurance from your school, your team(s) will not be competing in this Meet.
- 4. Each of us responsible for organizing this Meet must receive some very important items from you so that we can do our best for you and your athletes:

HIGH JUMP


Coaches & Athletes:

Any competitor **leaving** the High Jump event to compete in **another event** must first check in with the High Jump official.



If the **excused competitors** fail to return within the five minute period, they must take their remaining trials at the **HIGHER HEIGHT**.

- (1) **ALL COACHES** or their **REPRESENTATIVES** must attend these meetings or their entry **CANNOT** be accepted. Coaches/Representatives are expected to be present for the entire meeting.

SEEDING RULES

(1) DECLARATION PERIOD: 7:30 - 8:00 pm If you have over-entered an athlete, you must scratch down to the required number of events before the seeding meeting begins. No additions may be made to your entry. If you leave an athlete over-entered on your entry, the scratch decision will be made by MEET MANAGEMENT.

YOU MUST PAY FOR ALL EVENTS CHECKED. PLEASE DO NOT COMBINE CHECKS FROM THE COUNTY RELAYS WITH THE COUNTY CHAMPS

- (2) The 1600m Relay cards will be completed at the seeding meeting. When you enter the meet on Direct Athletics; please list 8 runners for the event.
- (3) We will seed by the order of events.

(4) We will only accept **RUN TIMES** and **THROWN DISTANCES**.

- (6) The number of athletes running in the seeded heats will be determined at the meeting.
- (7) All starting heights will be verified at the meeting, they are listed on the entry form, but can be changed if the need arises.
- (8) Seeded sections will run first in all running events.
- (9) Seeded sections in the Shot Put, Discus, & Long Jump, will throw or jump last, if there is a problem with the weather the order will be reversed. The seeded section in the Javelin will throw first. Seven (7) athletes will advance to the finals in each event

From 287 North:

Take Exit 44 (Main St./Boonton). Make a sharp left at end of ramp onto Lathrop Avenue. Pass Boonton HS and several homes on the left. Turn left into entrance to high school parking lot behind the school.

Bus:

From 287 North take exit 45 / Wootton St. At end of ramp continue to the first stop sign and turn right onto Wootton St. Go to T-stop and turn right onto Lathrop Ave. Pass John Hill School on your left and take your first right into the parking lot in the back of Boonton High School.

From 287 South: (Bus & Cars)

Take Myrtle Ave. exit. Turn left at end of ramp onto Myrtle Ave. At 2nd traffic light turn left onto Wootton street. Continue on until the road T-stops onto Lathrop Avenue. Turn right. Pass John Hill School on your left. Take next right into entrance to Boonton HS parking lot behind the school.

From 46 East :

Take the exit for Passaic, Fairfield and Lincoln Park. Take a Left and go over Rt. 46. Go to the stop sign and turn left onto Two Bridges Rd. Go to stop sign. Bear Left onto Pine Brook Rd. Go about 1 mile up the hill and turn left onto West Pine Brook Rd. Go about 1 mile passing a Convalescent Home on the left. Take the 2nd Deer Run entrance to the Golf Course.

From 46 West:

Take the exit for Passaic, Fairfield and Lincoln Park. Bear right at the end of the ramp onto Passaic Avenue. Go to the stop sign and turn left onto Two Bridges Rd. Go to stop sign. Bear Left onto Pine Brook Rd. Go about 1 mile up the hill and turn left onto West Pine Brook Rd. Go about 1 mile passing a Convalescent Home on the left. Take the 2nd Deer Run entrance to the Golf Course.
