DIRECTIONS: River Green Complex (Scott Hudgens Park) 4545 River Green Parkway NW, Duluth, GA 30096

River Green Parkway is located off Peachtree Industrial Boulevard between Pleasant Hill Road and Abbotts Bridge Road (Hwy 120).

From I-85 South: Exit Sugarloaf Parkway and turn right on Sugarloaf Parkway. Go several miles until Sugarloaf Parkway dead-ends at Peachtree Industrial Boulevard. Turn left on Peachtree Industrial Boulevard. Go several miles (one light past Abbotts Bridge) and turn right at the light on River Green Parkway (AGCO Tractors is on the right corner). Follow the winding road to the cross country course on the right.

From I-85 North: Exit Pleasant Hill Road and turn left on Pleasant Hill Road. Go several miles (past the Gwinnett Medial Center – Duluth hospital) and turn right on Peachtree Industrial Boulevard (there is a Kroger and McDonalds across the intersection). Turn left at the second light onto River Green Parkway (AGCO Tractors is on the left corner). Follow the winding road to the cross country course on the right.
