## Bobby's Story

Everything was going great for Robert (Bobby) Colantonio Jr, or 'Baby Bobby' as he is affectionately known by his family. In fall 2016 he had recently graduated from Barrington High School and was prepared to start classes at the University of Alabama on a full athletic scholarship for the track and field hammer throw.



Bobby worked hard for his scholarship putting in countless hours practicing and perfecting his technique. His mom Donna and dad Robert 'Big Bobby' showed their support too, driving to meets and cheering on their son every step of the way. Mom and dad were so proud as Bobby won state, regional and even national titles. His most impressive achievement was qualifying to represent the USA on a world level not once but TWICE!



The first week at the University of Alabama, Bobby noticed some pain in his knee. He didn't think much about it but the coach thought they should check it out. When the x-rays and MRI came back Bobby expected it might be a tendon or pulled muscle at worst. What he did not expect was a diagnosis of Ewing's sarcoma, a type of tumor that forms in bone or soft

tissue. With only a couple hundred cases each year this is one of the rarest forms of cancer and is found predominately in adolescents.

Bobby and his family have been faced with the unthinkable, dealing with an illness that no one should have to face. But they are a family that does not give up and they have pledged to fight this cancer all the way.
