Day-of-Meet Information

Coaches:

We look forward to hosting you and your teams at the Double-District Meet (4A-1 and 3A-6) next Wednesday! Parking will be a little tricky due to school being in session. So, in order to get everyone as close to the track and parked, we will follow a slightly different traffic pattern than in the past.

If you are coming west on SR-100 from I-95, <u>turn RIGHT on Bulldog Drive</u> (red light) prior to the main school entrance. If you are coming EAST on SR-100 from US1, <u>turn LEFT on Bulldog Drive</u> (red light) AFTER the main school entrance. Follow Bulldog Drive down until you are directly across from the visitor's side of the stadium, the BIG side gate to the parking lot will be open with people to direct you. UNLOAD all of your athletes and equipment here and you can enter the stadium through this side gate. Each of your athletes and coaches will receive a <u>colored wristband</u> that will allow them access to come and go from the stadium as needed. Any athletes or coaches coming later, you (the head coach) will be responsible for handing them their wristbands for entry. We will have a wristbands pre-packaged based on your district registration numbers. Teams will have 4 x coaching wristbands unless you email me otherwise. Buses will be directed north a long Bulldog Drive and will be able to park in Town Center, either in the grass lot to the right of the road or in available asphalt spaces. Buses can return after 2:30pm if they'd prefer to park closer.

A few housekeeping reminders, please *do not* allow your athletes to wander around FPC's campus especially while school is in session prior to 2:00pm, security will pick them up and they will be disqualified from the meet. Team tent areas are allowed on the visitor's side stands and the backfield areas. No tents will be allowed on the home side or near the concessions. We will have trash bags for your team areas, please use these to help us keep the stadium clean.

Athletes and coaches are not allowed onto the track or the infield once the meet has started, unless the clerk has directed that way as an upcoming event. Please let you athletes know they are not to jump fences. The warm-up area is in the backfield. The entrance to the track will at the CLERK at the north end of the track by the 100m start. Athletes will exit from the finish line and be able to walk around either side of the stands.

We will have hard copy of heat sheets at the coaches' meeting in the middle of the field at 9:00am. We will have heat sheets posted on our results boards, as well as one PRINTED copy of PRELIM results at the end of prelims for each results board (north and south end).
