High School - There is a 12-team limit for this meet, with a first-come, first-served policy. Please indicate, by emailing me your "intention to compete" by March 15, 2013, if you will be attending the meet. Entries will be online at CO-Milesplit and will be accepted up until 11:59pm on Sunday April 13th. Please include only official times from the 2014 season. If the represented time is from an indoor meet, please indicate as such.

For 2014, there will be six featured events; Special Olympics 100m, Coaches 400m run/hobble, Citizen's/Elite/Alumni 400m, 3200m, and mile events, and Citizen's shot put. In the mile event athletes will, as always, be attempting to break the 4-minute barrier. The entry fee for the Citizen's shot put, 400m and mile races will be \$15, with all proceeds going to the Durango Track & Field team. Put your money where your mouth is (or legs and arms are) and take on the DHS athletes in a winner takes all stakes!! If you win your event, and run faster or throw further than the high school athlete winners, we will present you with a \$50 dinner certificate to one of Durango's finest restaurants.
