Dear Coach:

Thanks for accepting our invitation to attend the 2017 Big Red Relays, hosted by Belton High School. Enclosed you will find a general itinerary, event map, parking information, exchange zone color code and track identification information. The Big Red Relays will be held on Saturday February 25, 2017. Entry fees that have not been taken care of prior to February 20th need to be paid at the meet. Registration form attached if you need it.

There are a few things we would like help with from you and your staff.

- Camps will be set up in the visitor's stands. Camps will be allowed underneath the stands, but we would prefer as many camps as possible in the bleachers.
- No camping on the infield.
- Keep athletes off the field. They will be escorted from the warm up area when it is time to run and escorted back once they finish the race.
- Do not allow athletes to sit on high jump or pole vault pits.
- Clean up your area after the meet.
- Keep athletes in the facility and out of the parking lots and around the buses.
- Make note of the parking instructions: Your driver must park in the Parking Lot behind the visitors bleachers between the baseball stadium and the old field house.
- The press box will be locked. Results will be posted on microsoport.com, as well as announced over the P.A.
- Medals will be awarded for 1st – 3rd in each division. Team Champion and Runner Up and Relay Champions plaques will be awarded as well.

The Big Red Relays will be FAT.

Registration will be done on direct athletics. Registration has been opened and will close on February 23rd at 6:00 p.m. https://www.directathletics.com/my_meets.html

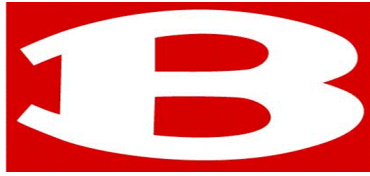

The Belton Athletic Booster Club will also be selling team meals for \$6. They do a really good job with this and all money goes directly to support our athletic program and scholarship fund.

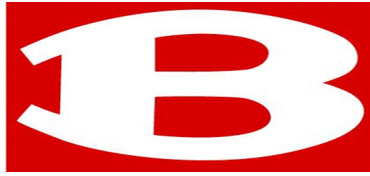
Meal tickets will be passed out at scratch meeting.

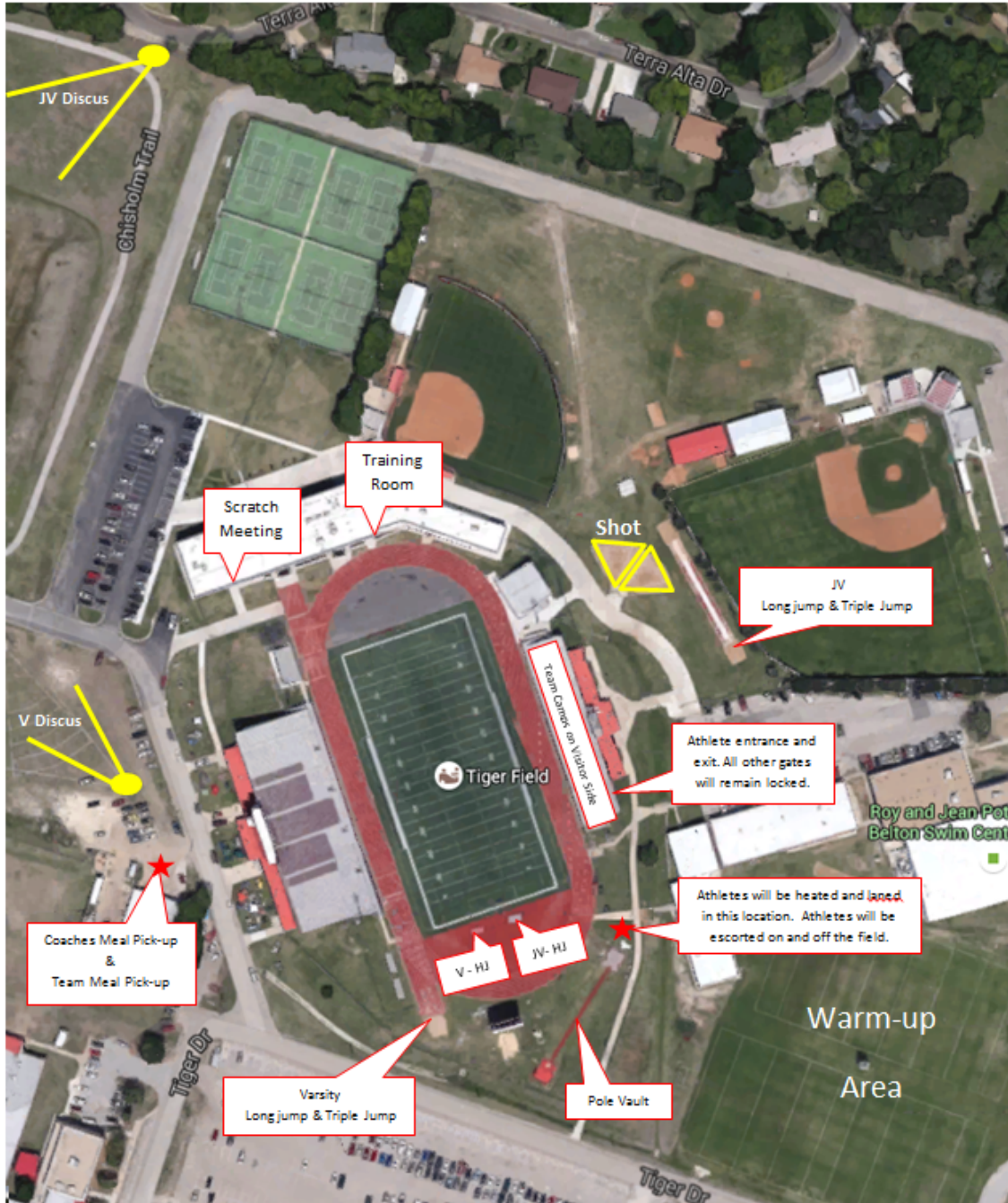

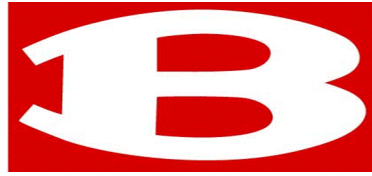
