Location:

Western Regional/ Grand Canal Liner Park. Park is located just West of 81st Avenue on Bethany Home Road

<u>From the South 101</u>: Take Camelback Road exit and go East approximately 2 miles turn North on 83rd Avenue Go north approximately 1 mile, turn West on Bethany Home Rd.

<u>From the North 101:</u> Take the Glendale exit and go east approximately 2 miles, turn South on 83rd Avenue Go South approximately 1 mile, turn West on Bethany Home Rd.

<u>Parking:</u> The City of Glendale is requiring that all vehicles transporting athletes be parked off site to allow spectator parking. Division 1 Schools will park in the church parking lot South and East of the meet site. Division 3 Schools will use the parking area directly South of the meet site. You may unload at the site and then park your vehicle. (This includes Vans and Mini Busses)

10:30 am Division III Girls

11:15 am Division III Boys

Awards for each Division Four will begin following their girls race Medals will be awarded to the top fourteen (14) in each sectional.

Course:

The course will start and finish on the soccer field. The length is 5K and the course is grass, dirt and some asphalt and sidewalk. Copy of map is attached.

Section Entry Procedure:

Each team must designate up to seven runners. Entries are to be submitted online at www.athletic.net

Entry deadline is Tuesday, October 25. Changes to your entries will be allowed at check in. I would recommend that you add this meet to your calendar.

<u>IF you do NOT have an Athletic.net account you need to allow several days for you account to be set.</u>

State Qualification:

QUALIFYING STANDARDS:

• The top 50% of scoring teams from each sectional race along with the top 25 runners from each sectional race will qualify to compete in the state championship meet, (if an odd number of scoring teams the number of qualifying teams round up). Example: 11 scoring teams at a Sectional qualify 6 teams. Participants must finish the course.
