Deadline: Online entry must be completed by Wednesday, September 26 at midnight.
Cost: $\quad \$ 60$ per team (girls and boys, HS and MS are separate teams. For example, if you are entering a HS boys and a HS girls team it would be $\$ 120$; HS and MS, boys and girls would be $\$ 240$.) Make checks payable to Darlington School and mail to Alan Parish, Darlington School, 1014 Cave Spring Rd SW, Rome, GA 30161.
Roster: Everyone in all races must be listed on your Milesplit roster (JV runners included. MS coaches please add any elementary runners for the 2 K race to your roster). You do not need to state your top 10 or which race a runner will participate in. It is best to put as many names on your roster as possible, even if some of them end up not running. Adding names late is difficult, but having extra names in the computer system is no problem. All runners in all races must wear a bib number.

> Community/Open 5 K race, 8:00 a.m. Elementary ( $1^{\text {st }}-5^{\text {th }}$ grades) 2 K race, 11:30 a.m.

LOCATION: Starts on the Darlington soccer fields, park at the Huffman Athletic Center.
REGISTRATION: By mail or register on race day from 7:30 to 8:00 a.m. Elementary one-mile participants can continue to register up until 10:30 a.m. on race day but it helps us significantly if you register in advance. (Coaches of HS and MS teams, please add elementary runners to your Milesplit roster.)

COST: $\$ 10$ per person for Open 5K, Elementary 2K race is free (but you must still register)! Make checks payable to Darlington School and mail to Alan Parish, Darlington School, 1014 Cave Spring Rd SW, Rome, GA 30161.

Note: there is no free t-shirt for this event, but you will be able to purchase one after your race.
5K AWARDS: Trophies to top 3 male and top 3 female finishers (no age group awards)
ELEMENTARY AWARDS: Top 10 girls and top 10 boys will receive medals as they cross the finish line.
