Registration: Registration begins at 8:30 AM and will continue until 11:00 AM in the William Linnell Gymnasium. The entry fee for individuals is \$20.00 and \$35.00 for relays. All payments must be made in cash or by check made payable to the NEW ENGLAND COUNCIL, **NO P.O.'S ACCEPTED**. All payments must be made at the time of registration.

Entry Limit: Each state will be allowed 6 entries per event. No athlete may compete in more than 4 events including relays. Athletes cannot compete in more events than his/her State Association allows.

Rules: NFHS rules will be followed.

Admission: General admission is \$10.00; children under school age will be admitted free. Only 2 coaches and athletes entered in the meet will be allowed to enter with the team.

Time Schedule/Order of Events

Track events will begin at 10:30 AM; finals of the high hurdles will begin at 12:30 PM. Field events will begin at 10:00 AM including boy's shot put, javelin, long jump and high jump. Starting at 10:00AM for girls will be long jump, pole vault and discus. Opening heights in the girl's high jump will be 5'0" and the boy's high jump will start at 6'0". Both will go up 3 inches after the opening height and then go up 2 inches at a time. Opening height in the girl's pole vault will be 9'0" and the boy's will be 12'6". Both will go up 9 inches after the opening height and then go up 6 inches at a time.

Order of running events (girls followed by boys)

12:30	100/110 m Hurdle Finals 100m Dash Finals 1600 m Run 4x100m Relay 400m Dash 300m Hurdles Finals 800m Run 200m Dash 3200m Run 4x400m Relay

All field events will be arranged so that best qualifying performances will compete last. In the shot put, discus, javelin, long jump and triple jump the top 8 will go to the finals. In the high jump and pole vault we will use the "5 alive" procedure. In the 100/110 hurdles and the 100m dash the 8 fastest times will advance to the finals. All other running events will be run in sections with the fastest section running last.

Spikes: 1/8 inch maximum for track and jumping events. Long javelin spikes may be worn for the javelin. **No spikes may be worn in the gym.**

School Reps: All competitors must have an adult representative of their school present in order to compete.

Equipment: Implements will be weighed beginning at 8:45AM. Priority will be given to events starting at 10:00AM. You may bring your own blocks. Batons will not be provided.

Lockers: No locker room facilities will be available. Please come dressed to compete.

Awards: Top six individuals and relays in each event will receive awards. Be present when called for the award ceremony.

Directions: From North or South take Maine Turnpike (interstate 95) to exit 36, Saco. Go through plaza to exit 2A, Saco Downtown. Turn right onto route 1 South. Go 1/4 of a mile and the stadium will be on the right. Parking for buses will be in lot adjacent to the gym. To get to the gym, go past the stadium onto Fairfield Street. Spectator parking will be at the end of the street.
